

3.3: Definition of a school librarian, includes the "**complex roles** of instruction, reading and literacy development, school library management, **collaboration with teaching staff**, and engagement with the educational community" (IFLA, 2015, p. 25).





3.4: Competencies needed to provide school library programs, including **communication and collaboration skills** (IFLA, 2015, p. 26).

3.5.1: Instruction, including **professional development for teachers** (IFLA, 2015, p. 27).






3.5.3: Leadership and Collaboration: "A school librarian's main role is to contribute to the mission and goals of the school. In **collaboration with the school's administrators and teachers**, the librarian develops and implements curriculum-based library services and programs that support teaching and learning for all" (IFLA, 2015, p. 28).



- Using interpersonal skills and knowledge to positively influence:
 - Other people's values;
 - Other people's behaviors;
 - Other people's priorities.
- Leaders must be willing to take risks and step out of their comfort zone in order to influence others.




Global View:Systems Thinking




